The RISW originated in the 1990s, by the FDA Statistical Association for FDA statisticians. Since its modest inception, the RISW has grown and evolved to provide an invaluable forum for discussions and informational exchanges among regulatory and industrial statisticians. Today, the RISW continues to provide opportunities for members of the statistical community to share ideas about advancing the boundaries of statistical science to enhance medical product development.

Over 1,000 statisticians—representing regulatory, industry, and academia—are expected to attend and/or participate in the upcoming workshop. 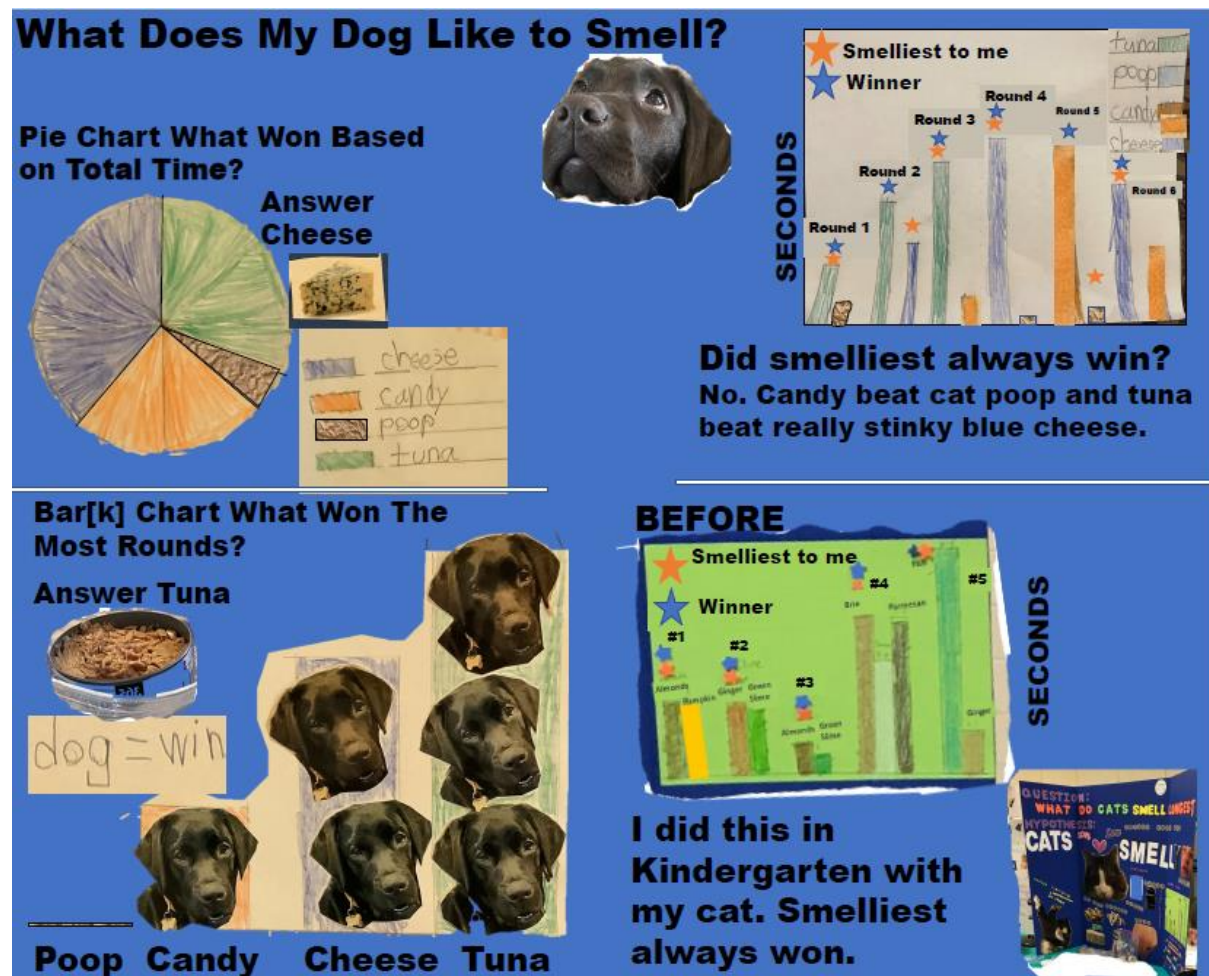
Congratulations to the 2023 winners and their fantastic work! Hope you enjoy viewing the work from some of the winners – namely our future statisticians – as much as we do!

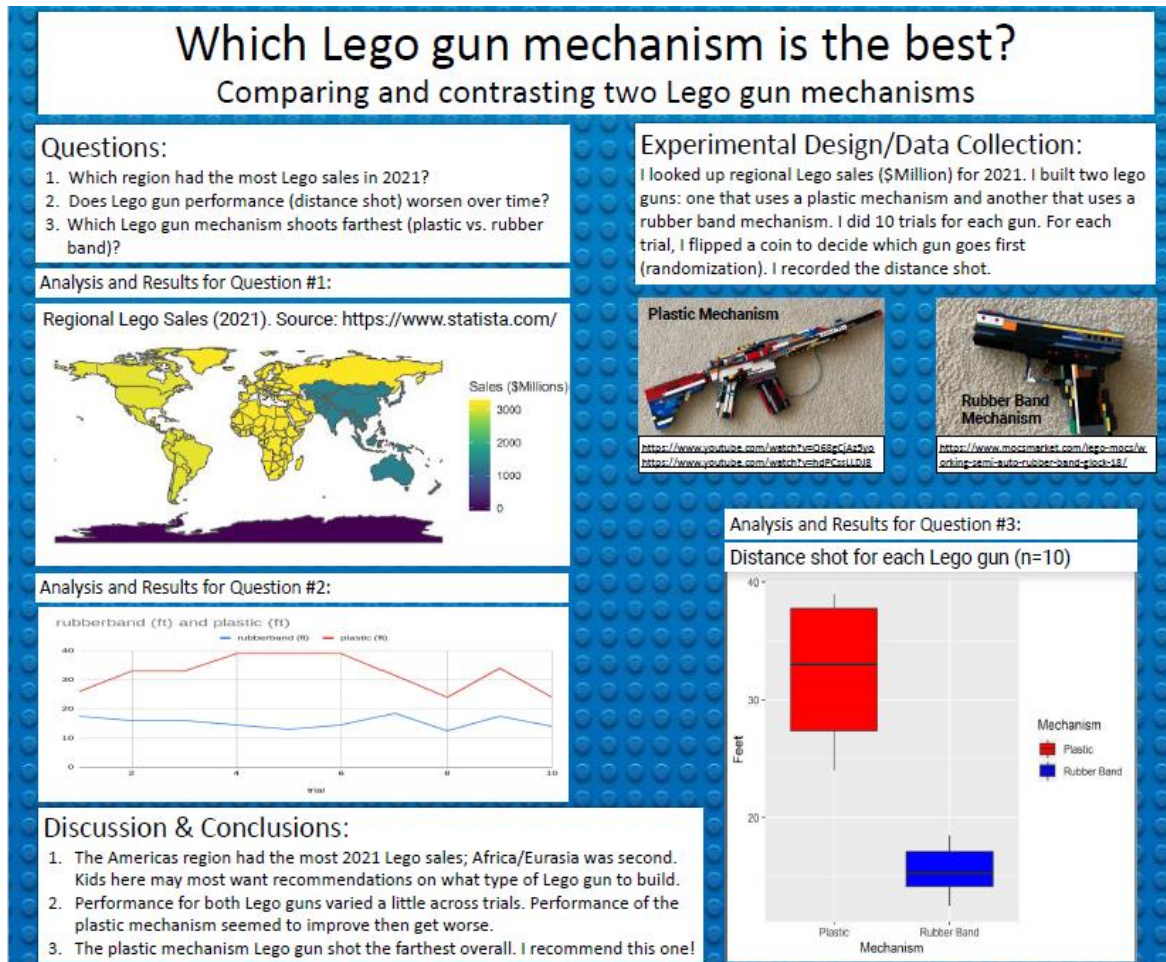

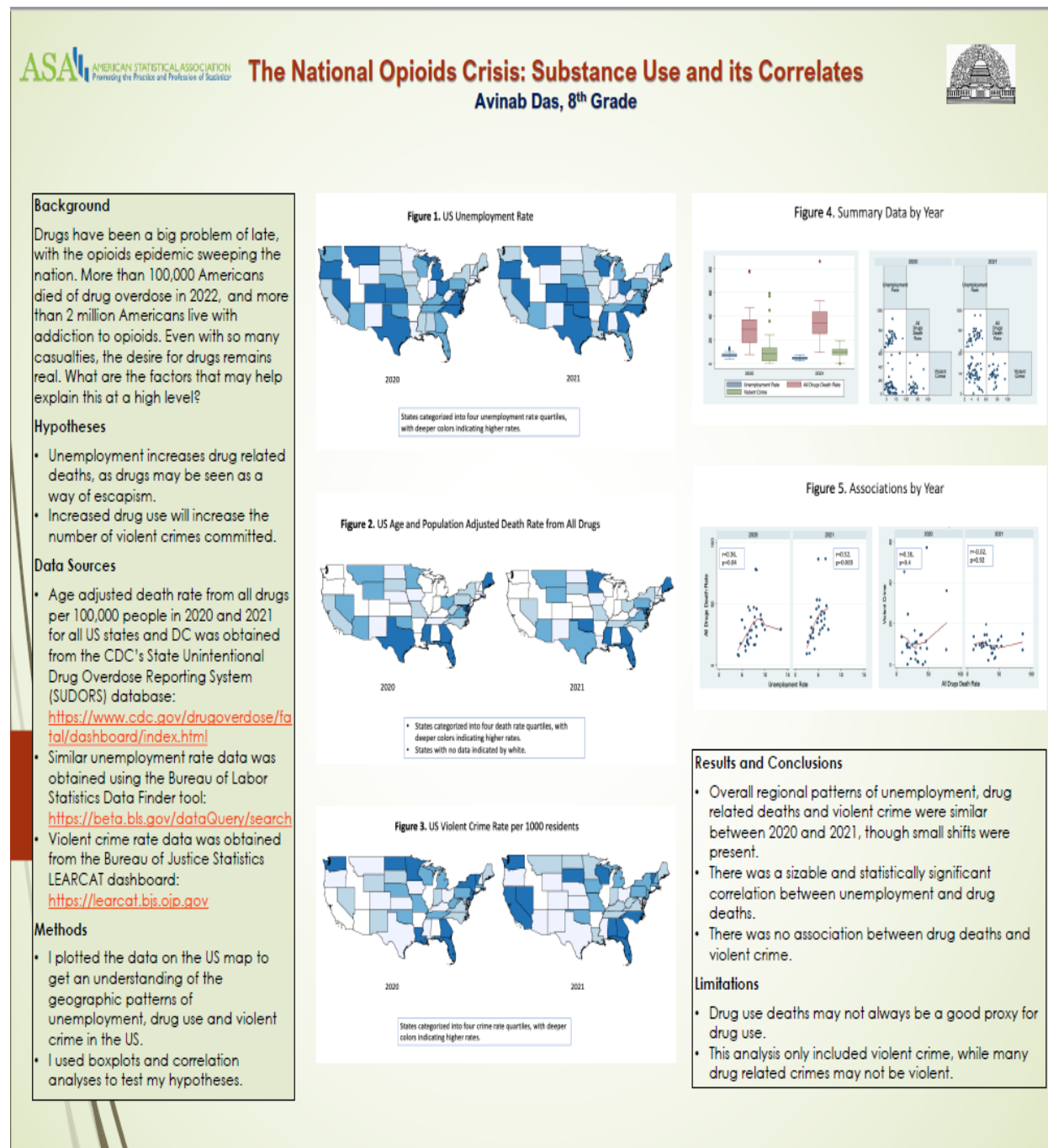

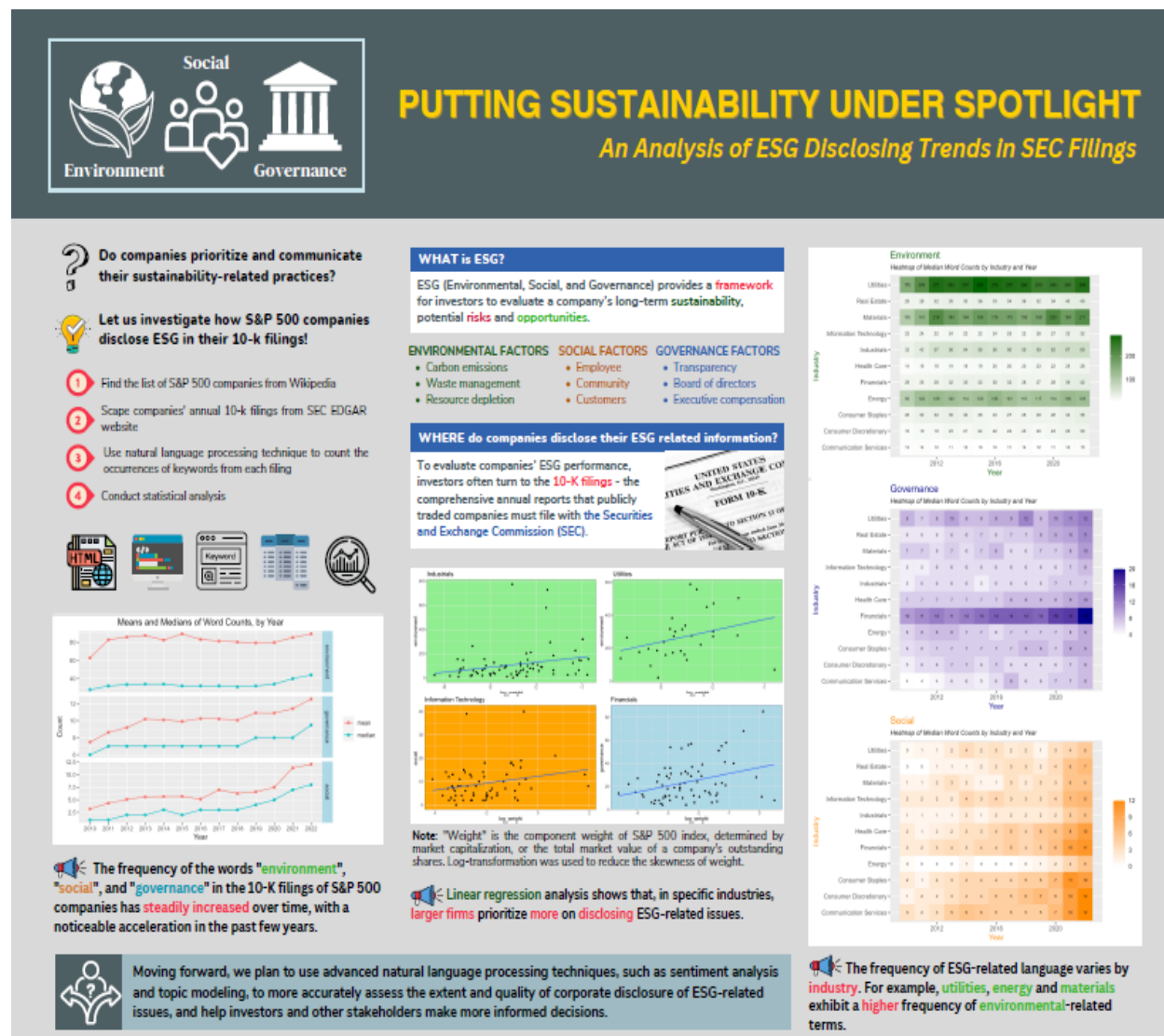
