STATISTICAL ACTIVITIES OF THE MEDICAL RESEARCH COUNCIL

March 23, 1953

Professor A. Bradford Hill of the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, immediate Past-President of the Royal Statistical Society, will be in Washington for a lecture and consultation at the National Institutes of Health, March 20 - 23.

We have been fortunate in getting Professor Hill to talk informally to us about the statistical activities of the Medical Research Council in which he is the Honorary Director of the Statistical Research Unit. After his talk he has agreed to answer questions of a more general statistical nature. Dr. Harold F. Dorn of the National Institutes of Health will lead the discussion and Mr. Felix E. Moore of the National Institutes of Health will preside.

The meeting will be held at 8 P. M., Monday, March 23, in Room 101, Hall of Government, George Washington University, 21st and G Streets, N.W.
