SUBJECT: Experiment and Simulation in the Social Sciences

It is commonly thought that the social sciences offer few, if any, possibilities for experiments. This view can no longer be maintained given modern techniques of simulation and observation. Professor Morgenstern will give a popular exposition of some of the modern techniques.

Dr. Morgenstern, a Fellow of A. S. A., is an international authority on the theory and use of statistical methods in the social sciences. His pioneering work with John von Neumann on the theory of games is widely recognized as the foundation of that subject. He has continued to do fundamental research in statistical strategy. His theories have been applied to problems in sociology, psychology, economics, politics and military strategy. He is currently Professor of Political Economy at Princeton University.
